**The Rhodes Scholarships - Full tuition, fees and stipend for two years of graduate study at the University of Oxford.** Scholarships awarded to multi-talented students with proven intellectual and academic achievement of the highest standard. Applicants must have integrity of character, the ability to lead, energy and physical vigor. Candidates must be nominated by Transylvania. A total of 32 American Rhodes Scholars are selected from eight U.S. districts. [www.rhodesscholar.org](http://www.rhodesscholar.org) and [www.ox.ac.uk](http://www.ox.ac.uk)

**The Gates Cambridge Scholarships - Full tuition, fees, living expenses and travel for graduate study at the University of Cambridge.** Applicants must have an exceptional record and be admitted to the University of Cambridge. **British Marshall Scholarships - Full tuition, fees, living expenses and travel for two years of graduate study at any British university.** To qualify, students should have a grade point average of not less than 3.7 and hold a bachelor's degree by the time they take up their scholarship. Preference will be given to candidates who combine high academic ability with the capacity to play an active part in the life of a British University. Up to 40 scholarships awarded. **Davies-Jackson Scholarship - Full tuition, fees, living expenses and travel for one or two years of graduate study at St. John's College, University of Cambridge.** The scholarship is designed for students with modest economic backgrounds and who are among the first in their families to have graduated from college. Open to majors in anthropology, classics, economics, English, foreign language, geography, history, history of art, music, philosophy, social and political sciences. **Fulbright Scholarships - Awards for graduate study, research, or teaching abroad. Round-trip transportation, tuition and maintenance for one year.** Approximately 670 awards to over 100 countries. <http://us.fulbrightonline.org/home.html>

**Rotary Foundation Ambassadorial Scholarship - All fees and transportation for one year of academic study abroad.** Students apply one year in advance to local Rotary clubs [www.rotary.org/en/studentsandyouth/educationalprograms/ambassadorialscholarships/pages/ridefault.aspx](http://www.rotary.org/en/studentsandyouth/educationalprograms/ambassadorialscholarships/pages/ridefault.aspx)

**Harry S Truman Scholarships - up to \$30,000 awarded** to college juniors who have outstanding leadership potential and plan to pursue a graduate degree and career in public service, e.g., government, education, the nonprofit sector, or the public interest/ advocacy sector. Candidates must be nominated by Transylvania. Up to 80 scholarships awarded. Scholars are required to work in public service for 3 of the 7 years following completion of a graduate degree program. <http://truman.gov/>

**Jacob K. Javits Fellowship - up to \$30,000 annually renewable for four years.** For doctoral or Master of Fine Arts study in the arts, humanities, and social sciences. [www.ed.gov/programs/jacobjavits/applicant.html](http://www.ed.gov/programs/jacobjavits/applicant.html)

**National Science Foundation Graduate Research Fellowships - \$30,000 stipend and \$10,500 for tuition and fees for up to three years.** Fellowships for graduate study leading to research-based master's or doctoral degrees in the mathematical, physical, biological, behavioral and social sciences, computer and information sciences, engineering, the history of science and the philosophy of science. Additional awards offered for women in engineering and computer and information science. GRE scores are required. [www.nsfgrfp.org/](http://www.nsfgrfp.org/)

**James Madison Memorial Fellowships - up to \$24,000 for two years graduate study.** For graduating seniors who wish to become secondary school teachers of American history, American government or social studies in grades 7-12. Fellowship is for full-time graduate study. At least one fellow per state selected. [www.jamesmadison.com](http://www.jamesmadison.com)

**Barry M. Goldwater Scholarships - up to \$7,500 annually for juniors and seniors.**

Undergraduate scholarships to cover tuition, fees, books and room and board to juniors and seniors who have outstanding potential and intend to pursue careers in mathematics, the natural sciences or engineering disciplines. Up to four candidates may be nominated by Transylvania; applications are not accepted directly from candidates. Up to 300 scholarships awarded. [www.act.org/goldwater](http://www.act.org/goldwater)

**Ford Foundation Pre-doctoral Diversity Fellowships - Annual \$20,000 stipend & \$2,000 tuition allowance per year for up to three years.** This is available to individuals engaged in graduate study leading to a Ph. D. or Sc.D., who seek to teach at the college/university level. All U. S. citizens or nationals are eligible; a positive factor for selection will be membership in groups underrepresented in the American professorate. The website lists eligible fields of study. **UNCF/Merck Science Initiative - Up to \$25,000** for African American junior year science majors interested in biomedical research. Each scholar will be mentored by a Merck scientist and will receive two summer internship stipends for a total of \$10,000. **BOREN Awards for International Study** - undergraduate scholarships and graduate fellowships for study abroad or language study. For academic year, semester, or summer study in languages and cultures of less commonly studied countries. Requires service to federal government or higher education. **Cralle Fellowship** - Transylvania may nominate **one** prospective graduate student and **one** prospective professional student for the Cralle Fellowship for graduate or professional (law, medicine, dentistry) study at the University of Kentucky. **Hertz Foundation Graduate Fellowships in Physical, Biological, or Engineering Sciences - \$28,000 + tuition, renewable for 5 years.** Fellowships for graduate work leading to the Ph.D. degree. [www.hertzfndn.org/](http://www.hertzfndn.org/)

**Morris K. Udall Scholarship** - 80 Merit scholarships for sophomores and juniors who have demonstrated commitment to careers related to the environment. Eligible fields include policy, science, education, urban planning, business, health, justice, and economics. Applicants must be nominated by Transy. **George J. Mitchell Postgraduate Scholarship** - Tuition, housing, and stipends for living and international travel stipend for 12 scholars between the ages of 18 and 30 for one year of postgraduate study in any discipline in Ireland and Northern Ireland.
